



Application of Sunscreen

In California daycare centers are governed by Title 22. This is what it says:

“More than half of all new cancers are skin cancers. Healthy skin care begins at childhood. We encourage licensees to use sunscreen on children! Title 22 licensing regulations, Section 101226(e) (4), Health-Related Services, requires CCCs to obtain written approval or instructions from parents prior to administering non-prescription medication to children in care. Sunscreen is considered a non-prescription medication. The approval or instructions must be maintained in the child’s file.”

We strive to keep your children safe. You are welcome to send hats etc. for your child to wear during outdoor play.

This is our policy for sunscreen application:

- Families apply sunscreen to their child before leaving them in our care
- Families provide appropriate sunscreen for their child – please label the container and leave with your classroom teacher
- Complete the permission form and leave it with Lynne – we are not allowed to apply sunscreen without your permission.
- We will apply sunscreen before the afternoon outdoor play session to all eligible students.
