

# Living Your Best Life NOW - Week II

# **Big Idea**

"The Jesus Life" - Freedom from the Misery of Religious Living"

Jesus asked Peter the <u>MOST</u> important question, "*Simon, Son of Jonas, do you love me*?" Read the Text: John 21:15-17 YLT. In today's language, Jesus would be asking us: "Is cultivating a growing and deepening <u>FRIENDSHIP</u> with me as a <u>PERSON</u> your <u>FIRST</u> and <u>HIGHEST</u> priority?" How did Peter respond? Peter responded, "Lord, I <u>PASSIONATELY</u> love you as my <u>DEAREST</u> & <u>CLOSEST</u> friend." Cultivating this friendship with Jesus is what makes the Christian life meaningful and deeply satisfying. It is what sets us free from the misery and boredom of religious living.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- Use a personal example in your own life and qualify the above introduction in this discuss. How do you experience life when you feel closest to God? How do you experience life when you're far away from God?
- List three things that may have stifled God's love in your heart and explain how it affected your relationship with God. Do you know what brought about or caused it?
- What immediate action step would you take to recapture your love for God?

### **Next Steps**

Honestly evaluate your own heart. Is your heart free? Have the cares of this world, the pressures of life, work and the home built resentment, bitterness, apathy, indifference, callousness, passivity or negativity? No matter what condition you find your heart to be in, open it to God and confess it to Him. Ask Him to heal the wounds of your heart and fill it with peace, joy and love.
