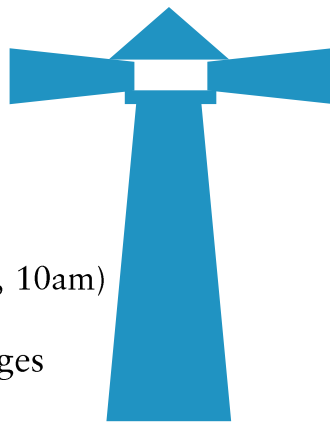
Amelia Island is named after [PRINCESS AMELIA](#), daughter of English King George II. Fernandina Beach is named after Spanish King Ferdinand VII.

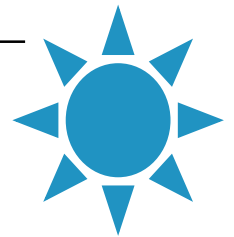

BEACH RULES

- Alcoholic beverages and glass containers are prohibited
- Beaches are pet friendly but must be leashed and must cleanup after pets
- State law prohibits walking or driving on sand dunes or picking sea oats
- Guests may not leave items overnight on the beach including tents and chairs
- Out-of-county residents must have a permit to drive or park on the beach. Permits can be obtained at the Historic Courthouse
- To help protect the sea turtles:
 - Fill in any holes you make in the sand
 - Keep artificial light shining on the beach to a minimum during nesting season by turning off outside lights and shielding indoor lights from shining out.
