

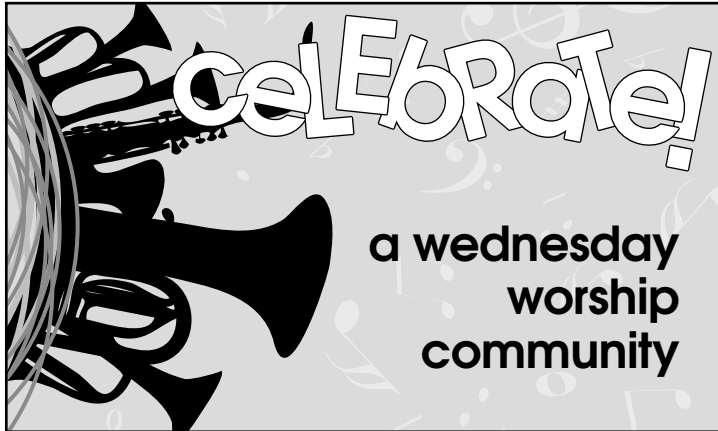

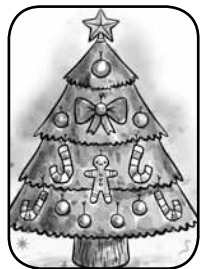
Following late worship: Noon–1:15 p.m.
