2018 Winter Mission Workcamp



Plans for our 2018 winter mission workcamp are well underway. Based on a variety of factors, we have selected the Sebring, Florida area as our destination. Sebring is about 80 miles south of Orlando. The area was hit hard by Hurricane

Irma. I've been in contact with the Florida UMC Disaster Response folks and they suggested Sebring. The Volunteer-in Mission Coordinator for Central Florida is based in Sebring and is on staff at the Sebring First United Methodist Church. The church has facilities to accommodate a group our size ... sleeping space, kitchen, and showers!

So, here are the details to date:

Dates: March 11-17, 2018
Staying at: First UMC, Sebring FL

Anticipated Cost: \$100/person for the week plus a contribution from

our Churches We will again have our own cook crew. Everyone except the RV folks will need a

cot or air mattress.

What will we be doing? The list sent by my contact in Sebring is as follows: installing insulation and sheetrock taping, mudding and texturing sheetrock, installing trim, doors, etc. installing flooring – laminate or similar, repairing roofs or shingles, replacing kitchen and bathroom cabinets, tearing out damaged materials, and other repair work as needed.

A pre-trip meeting has been scheduled at the Hagerstown UMC for Sunday, February 11, 2018, at 2:00 p.m. to share additional information, answer questions, and fill out needed forms.
