**Maundy Thursday:** What is a haystack meal? It is similar in concept to nachos, taco salad, and tostadas. You start with a starch base like crackers and rice, and add things like meat, veggies, and condiments. We are asking participants to consider bringing an ingredient to contribute to the meal. Options include: saltine crackers, rice, shredded lettuce, ground beef, crushed nacho chips, chopped green peppers, onions, shredded cheese, sour cream, salsa, and olives, sesame seeds, pineapple, and nacho cheese sauce. We are also looking for a few volunteers who might be willing to offer loaves of freshly baked bread for communion. Keep an eye out for sign up sheets!
