

**“Remembering Jesus in the Lord’s Supper” – Luke 22**

*Recall the moment you trusted Christ as your Lord & Savior receiving Him into your life.*

Jesus said: **“Do this in remembrance of Me.”** Luke 22:19

Our Lord commands us to remember His life, death, resurrection, and promised coming through participation in the Lord’s Supper.

**1. Remember it is \_\_\_\_\_ in the Passover.** Luke 22:14-15

When the hour came, he reclined at the table, and the apostles with him. <sup>15</sup> Then he said to them, “I have fervently desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer.

**2. Remember the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus’ Sacrifice.** Luke 22:19-20

<sup>19</sup> And he took bread, gave thanks, broke it, gave it to them, and said, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”

<sup>20</sup> In the same way he also took the cup after supper and said, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.

**3. Remember to \_\_\_\_\_ on your soul’s condition and attitude.** 1 Corinthians 11:27-28

So, then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sin against the body and blood of the Lord. <sup>28</sup> Let a person examine himself; in this way let him eat the bread and drink from the cup.
