The over-arching theme of this event will be found in the great revival verse of the Old Testament, 2 Chronicles 7:14.

As the year comes to an end, we want to thank those who have contributed so generously to Fruitbelt Farmworker Christian Ministry. Knowing that most of us face challenges in stretching the budget, we are sincerely grateful for your gift of \$623.25. Thanks, also, for the cases of chicken that you donated for the workers.

Donations received are used to enable ministry to seasonal and migrant farm workers in South Central Pennsylvania, plus a small area of Northern Maryland. Your funds have enabled us to visit farm workers in the migrant camps, counsel those in need, lead Bible Studies, co-ordinate services through local agencies, and share in crosscultural recreational opportunities. FFCM also provided the following to farmworkers: Bibles, blankets, sweatshirts, other clothing, food, and other donated items. We translated for a number of church groups who shared fellowship with workers in their camps.
