BESTWA TO DISTRIBUTE CRITICAL MEDICAL SUPPLIES IN EBOLA RAVAGED LIBERIA

Monrovia, Liberia (October 1, 2014) – BESTWA (Building Everyone’s Success Together in West Africa) announced today a chartered airlift arriving in Monrovia to distribute 2 Tons of high quality medical supplies to 28 hospitals and clinics fighting the Ebola Virus ravaging communities across Liberia.

Partnering in the \$2.6 Million Dollar Medical Air Shipment are: World Children’s Fund, Global Assistance, METAD, MMI-AT, MMI-IT, IRD, and BESTWA.

The air shipment is an official World Health Organization (WHO) Interagency Emergency Health Kit deemed a reliable, standardized, affordable and quickly available source of essential medicines and medical devices. The medical kit contains antibiotics, rehydration salts, anesthetics and anaphylaxis drugs meeting the health needs of 10,000 Liberian people for a period of three months.

“Obviously with a population of just over 4 million we are in a long battle to gain control over Ebola. We will continue to work feverishly to do what we can, praying the medical emergency will subside.” said Andy Perkins, Executive Director of BESTWA.
