Continuing the Journey to the Cross



April 2 Class & April 16 Service



Join us as we begin a new study on "Christ in the Old Testament." We will explore the lives of 13 biblical people who "prefigured" Christ. Throughout the Old Testament, God provided "saviors" for the people of Israel who would foreshadow the true, eternal Savior yet to come. Understanding stories such as Joseph or Abraham and how they point to Christ helps us trust in God's provision and wisdom in all things. During this study, we will examine types, parallels, and illustrations of Jesus throughout the Old Testament, including people such Adam, Noah, Abraham, Melchizedek, Joseph, King David, and many others. When viewed through the prism of Christ's life, death and resurrection, these Old Testament characters and their roles in biblical history take on new dimensions.





Missionary of the week, April 2017

- Apr 2 Ben & Elizabeth Hagerup –Ben is the COO, Director of Campus Ministry, Director of Pioneering working with DiscipleMakers (DM) in Pennsylvania. DM is working on several college campuses and is looking to add even more campuses as God provides staff. Elizabeth is home schooling six children (two in high school, one autistic, one with ADHD and a toddler.) Please pray for the Hagerups.
- Apr 9 Dawn Strauss Now retired, Dawn lives in California. Previously, she and her late husband Harvey worked at Alaska Bible College. Later, they were area representatives and recruiters for SEND, International, where her son, Scott, is a missionary with SEND, International.




Five Day Frenzy
