- 2. Support to Joshua Javery effective September 2016 when he returns to Poland. He is with SEND International and serves as a Church Planter. The amount approved is \$2,400 annually. We enjoyed hearing from Joshua in the am service July 31st. He has responded: *Praise the Lord. This is so very exciting. I feel very blessed! Thank you Bethany. God is good.*

Additional changes in Missionary Support:

- 1. Support of Marty and Debbie Shilling was discontinued effective June 30th. This decision was made because the specific ministry they are involved in is not ready to launch and has been delayed one year. They have returned to live in the United States.
- 2. Dick and Mavis Buck met with us in April and shared that God has blessed them during their retirement. They requested that their support be decreased from \$1500 to \$750 per year. This request became effective April 1st.
