What life situations have you experienced or are currently experiencing that you are asking the question who is this God and what is He like? - 3.) Spend time reading Isaiah 40:8-31. As you read it take note how God proclaims Himself to be incomparable. What are the implication of God being incomparable for us today?
- 4.) Read and discuss the following verses that talk about Jesus being our redeemer, noting what we were redeemed from: Galatians 3:13, 4:1-7, Titus 1:11-14, Hebrews 9:15.
- 5.) In what ways does your view of God need to be changed to better align with how God has reveal Himself to be?
