Creating new flexible learning rooms at the west end that will house Christian education for teens, adults and children.

Expanding our fellowship hall and kitchen to the east to create room for more tables and people for the many meal ministries.

Creating a new chapel to better serve worship gatherings, adult education, and other ministries.



Creating a large multi-purpose room south of the current education wing that will be used for fellowship events, recreational activities, alternative worship experiences, and more.

Re-creating the current chapel to provide both a new space for grace-filled connections in a casual coffee-shop atmosphere with tables for caring conversations as well as the bookstore and the key connection access corridor between the existing narthex, sanctuary, fellowship hall and offices and the new multi-purpose room.

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These drawings are concepts of one way this vision can be realized. The concept drawings grew out of listening conversations with many members and leaders. The leadership has been and will continue to be in conversations with CO-OP Architecture to refine and improve the concepts as this process continues.

Our great desire in this *Creating Room at the Table* appeal is to raise \$1.5 million toward a projected \$3 million for basic facility expansion. These initial cost estimates will increase as we clarify details, and decide upon equipment, furnishings, technology, new parking, etc. This goal of \$1.5 million in three-year pledges to this appeal, added to existing Development Fund monies will provide about 2/3 of the needed funding. Additional funding would be secured through a mortgage.
