

Chris sits alone. Chris had an another enormous fight with mom and dad, which ended when Chris got up and shot out of the room and out of the house. Now Chris is perched on a boulder in the yard of the neighbor across the street. Chris had told mom and dad not to follow or try to pretend that they loved Chris. Now, Chris worried that maybe they would believe that Chris really meant that. It was getting cold and the loneliness was turning into a self-imposed abandonment.

Then the door opens and dad and mom slowly come out of the house. They start walking over to the boulder. Chris spins around on the rock so that all they see is a defiant back; and so they cannot see a face that is everything except defiant. Please, keep coming, Chris thinks. And they do. They come and gather Chris into their arms, enduring the initial stiffening in order to receive the melting into their arms. Reconciliation begins.

Christmas is when Jesus comes to a world that has rejected God. Oh, sometimes there is a hope that God will seek us out, but sometimes we are utterly convinced that we get along better without God. God just isn't relevant. So, Jesus takes on flesh and blood and shows us what it would be like to live in the presence of a loving God whose purpose is, not to be served, but to serve and give his life as a ransom for many. When we see God in Jesus, we melt into those gracious and forgiving arms. This is Christmas - God coming to where God isn't welcome but who brings welcome that opens us to God in Jesus.

This is why we celebrate. This is why we sing. We hope you will join us at one of our Christmas Eve worship services. We worship at 4:00, 7:00, and 11:00 on December 24. Holy Communion and Candle lighting are at all services. On Christmas Day, Sunday, December 25 we will have one worship service at 10:00am, with Holy Communion.


