

## Curriculum List Information & Recommendations

- **July 15<sup>th</sup> Finish Date:** It can take several weeks for books to be delivered so try to have all book orders placed *before* July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- **Vendors:** The vendors listed on the curriculum lists are only recommendations. You may often find used books online via amazon.com, cbd.com as well as at used book fairs, such as Legacy holds in the beginning of June of each year.
- **LCA Curriculum Lists - Now Online with The Homeschool Hangout:** Hanno and Peggy Berg, owners of the Homeschool Hangout bookstore, have graciously created curriculum lists on their website with LCA's curriculum. You may purchase the majority of your curriculum online simply by going to [www.hshangout.com/store/legacy-community-academy](http://www.hshangout.com/store/legacy-community-academy), then choose the grade, add the items you need to your cart, and check out. The items will be ready for pick up at the store, which is located about one mile from Legacy at 162 Marietta St, Alpharetta, GA 30004. The phone number to the store is (770) 569-4977.
- **Importance of ISBN #s:** If ISBN #'s are listed, please be sure to order that specific edition of the book as generally page numbers will be assigned based upon that specific edition.
- **Stretch:** There are stretch items listed at the bottom of kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum lists. These items are optional and may be used to "stretch" your student.
- **Summer Reading:** Summer reading is attached at the bottom of the K – 8<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum lists and in the humanities portion of the High School Course Catalogue.
- **Supply Lists:** Supply lists are listed separately and will be attached in a separate document
- **Handy-Dandy Parent Idea:** Highlight items in yellow that you already have and highlight items in blue as you order them. Then write the date and vendor to the right of the ordered item as a reference for you when you are trying to remember who and when you ordered the books :) You may want to also list the date that the item is expected to be delivered.
