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SESSION ACTIONS TAKEN IN JANUARY

The Session meets on the second Thursday of the month. These meetings are open (voice may be granted by action of the Session). There may be rare occasions when the discussion is of a confidential nature and that portion of the meeting must be closed. The following actions were taken at the most recent meeting of Session.

- Completed evaluations of staff and approved maintaining current staff salary levels through Easter
- Approved moving the Baptismal Font to the entry into the Sanctuary until Easter
- Approved scheduling a Noon Worship Service each Wednesday during Lent and a Worship Service on Good Friday.
- Established the 2013 Communion Schedule:
 - During Sunday Worship:
 - 9:30 am— The first Sunday of each month, and each Sunday during Lent (February 17-March 24)
 - 10:45 am— For *Community Worship Services* on Easter Sunday (March 31), World Communion Sunday (October 6), the first Sunday of Advent (December 1), and as required by Elders and Worship Leaders
 - During Worship:
 - Mid-week (Wednesdays, 5:30 pm) - Ash Wednesday (February 13) and through Lent (February 20-March 27)
 - Special Days— Maundy Thursday (March 28) and Christmas Eve (both services).
- Accepted a proposal from Kone for a required annual No Load Safety Test of the elevator.
- Elected the following slate of officers:
 - Frank Lambert as Treasurer; Brian McMaster as Clerk of Session; Brian McMaster, Sarah Nimrick, and Helen Smith as Financial Secretaries; Helen Smith and Brian McMaster as Session Members of the Nominating Committee; Session Ruling Elders as Trustees of the Broadway Presbyterian Church Corporation, and
- Made the following appointments:
 - Yancy Bolden as Representative to Quad City Interfaith; Tika Bista and Brian McMaster as Delegates to Quad City Alliance for Immigrants and Refugees; Sue Liggitt and Mike Clark as members of the Memorial Team
- Established at least six scholarships (based on need) to Stronghold for 2013, with funding from the Memorial Fund.
- Appointed a fiscal agent from Session, for the High-Tunnel project for the International Garden at 8th Avenue and 19th Street, and the Treasurer, to provide notice to USDA, for this application.
