## SESSION ACTIONS TAKEN IN JANUARY

The Session meets on the second Thursday of the month. These meetings are open (voice may be granted by action of the Session). There may be rare occasions when the discussion is of a confidential nature and that portion of the meeting must be closed. The following actions were taken at the most recent meeting of Session.

- Completed evaluations of staff and approved maintaining current staff salary levels through Easter
- Approved moving the Baptismal Font to the entry into the Sanctuary until Easter
- Approved scheduling a Noon Worship Service each Wednesday during Lent and a Worship Service on Good Friday.
- Established the 2013 Communion Schedule:
  - During Sunday Worship:
    - 9:30 am
      - The first Sunday of each month, and
      - Each Sunday during Lent (February 17-March 24)
    - 10:45 am
      - For *Community Worship Services* on
        - Easter Sunday (March 31)
        - World Communion Sunday (October 6)
        - The first Sunday of Advent (December 1), and
      - As required by Elders and Worship Leaders
  - During Worship:
    - Mid-week (Wednesdays, 5:30 pm)
      - Ash Wednesday (February 13) and
      - Through Lent (February 20-March 27)
    - Special Days
      - Maundy Thursday (March 28)
      - Christmas Eve (both services).
- Accepted a proposal from Kone for a required annual No Load Safety Test of the elevator.
- Elected the following slate of officers:

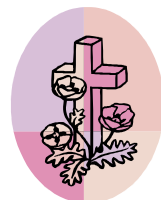

Our book to read for that meeting is:

Dark Torté by Diane Mott Davidson

At the start of bestseller Davidson's delicious 13th culinary adventure featuring caterer Goldy Schulz (after 2004's *Double Shot*), Goldy stumbles over the body of neighbor Dusty Routt, a paralegal at Hanrahan & Jule, a boutique law firm in Aspen Meadow, Colorado, with which Goldy has a lucrative contract to provide breakfasts and occasional lunches for its attorneys and well-heeled clients. By all accounts, Dusty's future was bright, no longer overshadowed by a tragic, poverty-stricken past. Her untimely death shatters her mother and grandfather, still reeling from the death of her brother while in police custody. When Dusty's mother, who distrusts the police, asks Goldy to investigate, the caterer feels she can't refuse. Between catering jobs, teaching son Arch how to drive and assuaging her own grief, Goldy chases down clues with the help of her policeman husband, Tom, and her catering partners. Though a few stones remain unturned (perhaps intentionally), Davidson delivers another entertaining whodunit with delectable recipes.
