## OUR MISSION

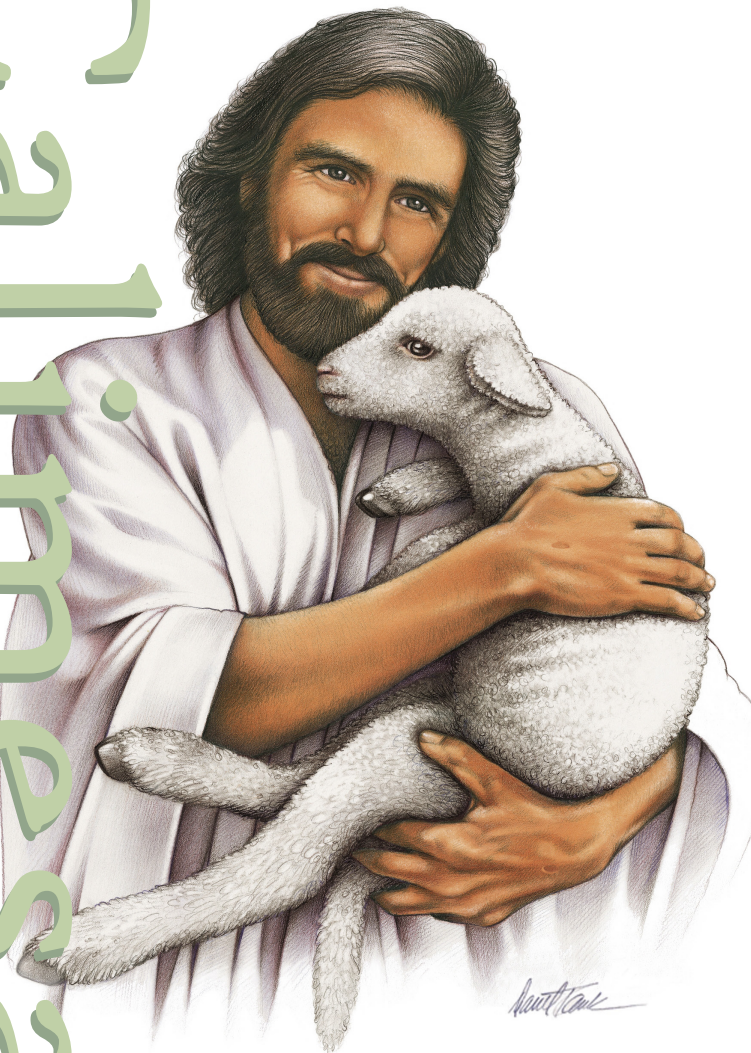
