



## **INFO & FORMS**

**July 6-11, 2014**

### **SCHEDULE**

Zona Camp is July 6-11 and is located at California Baptist University. We will meet at Calvary's Property (3090 Sweetwater) at 10am on Sunday, July 6 to leave. Do not be late. If your student is not present and loaded at the time of departure, they will be left behind! We will stop in Barstow for some free time and food during our drive to California and back. We will arrive back at Calvary's Parking Lot in the early afternoon of the 11th.

### **MONEY**

Cost for Zona Camp 2014 is **\$350** (all payments are non-refundable) with a deposit of \$100. Feel free to make multiple payments at your convenience. Final payment is due Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. You can signup or pay at any point, but after May 25<sup>th</sup> you must pay in full when signing up. Students also need money for a meal on the way there and a meal on the way back. We will collect \$10 when we get on the bus so they have money to eat with on the way back. Extra money for snacks and souvenirs is at the parents' discretion. The camp also collects a donation for a chosen charity. I HIGHLY encourage your student bring money for this!!!

**All signups are FINAL after May 25!** **If you drop out after this date you still owe the full payment or must find someone to replace your spot at camp!** **If you sign up after this date you must pay in full upon completion of registration!**

### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

Financial assistance is available, but the student must be willing to participate in fundraisers to qualify. Applications for assistance are attached to back of this form. Please do not apply for assistance if you don't need it! Financial assistance will be limited to campers only.

### **MANDATORY PARENT MEETINGS**

Parents of EVERY youth that wants to attend camp must have a meeting with Chad. This is mandatory, no exceptions will be made.

Three meetings are planned, and parents must attend only one. Guidelines/Rules for the camp will be addressed, and forms (medical release, etc) for the camp will be filled out at this meeting, so please have all relevant documents (insurance cards, etc) and information (allergies, list of medications, physician's name/phone, etc) with you at the meeting. The dates for those meetings are Saturday, June 7 at 4:30pm; Saturday, June 21 at 4:30pm; and Sunday, June 22 at 12:30pm. If a parent can not attend one of these dates, they MUST make arrangements with Chad for a private meeting.

### **DRESS CODE**

Since this is a Christian youth camp, we ask all campers/leaders to dress with this in mind.

The following is CBU's Policy:

- **Shirts:** Undergarments are not displayed. Cover the wearer's midriff and, for females, the chest/bust area as well. All garments must cover or be covered by the wearer's waist band while standing. No tube tops or spaghetti straps are allowed. Tank tops may be worn but straps must be two inches wide or wider.

- Shorts, skirts, and dresses are at a length that will allow the wearer's finger tips to touch the garment when arms and hands are fully extended, while standing.
- Swim suits – Females: swimwear must be a one-piece suit (no tankinis), covering cleavage, bust, and midriff areas; Thong, g-string and high French-cut styles are not acceptable. T-shirts are not to be worn over swimwear. Males: swimwear must be boxer style suits with at least a 5 inch inseam & a nylon or mesh liner
- Lewd clothing and clothing which displays alcohol, tobacco products, satanic symbols, and inappropriate language and/or symbols, is not permitted.

### **WHAT TO PACK**

- Bible, notebook, pencil
- Sleeping bag or bed roll and pillow
- Towels (for showering & swimming) and toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.)
- Clothes for 6 days – keeping in mind there will be time for worship, games, sports, etc.
- Close-toed shoes and work clothes for Mission Track
- Swim suits – see above for guidelines
- Extra spending money for food during trip (minimum of \$20), food at camp, and camp donation
- Camera (optional)
- \*Cell Phone (optional)

### **DON'T PACK THESE**

- \*\*Undesirable literature, Weapons, Illegal Drugs, Tobacco, Alcohol (immediately sent home for these)
- Water balloons, shaving cream (except for the purpose of shaving), or Hair Dye
- Laptops, external speakers, DVD players

### **EXPERIENCE CHOICES**

Zona Camp has four Experiences for students to choose from. Below are the Experiences to choose from (you MUST choose one).

- **ZONA EXPERIENCE**: ZONA experience is a high energy opportunity where students will enjoy small group bible studies mixed with a wide variety of classes and activities that they choose.
- **PROPEL MY LIFE**: Propel my life is for students who are ready for the next level in discipleship with a focus on worldview and apologetics. I HIGHLY recommend this to student leaders!!!
- **WORSHIP CATALYST**: WCE meets the unique needs of musicians, singers, actors and technologists helping them become great worship leaders.
- **MISSION LIFE**: Mission life is an on and off-campus mission experience for those students looking for a hands-on experience to serve others.

### **POLICIES**

As mentioned in the previous sections, a student may be sent home at the parent's expense for: breaking the rules, disrespect toward any leader, or other unruly behavior.

Due to space limitations each camper will be limited to **One suitcase and One carry-on.**

\*Students will be allowed to bring their cell phones with them this year, but they are not to be used anytime other than free time! If your student is caught using them at unauthorized times, they will be taken up and not returned until we return to Calvary's parking lot.

\*\*If any camper is found with one of these items he/she will be sent home at their parent's expense.

\*\*\*CBC, ZYC, and CBU are not responsible for any lost/stolen/broken items or money. Your student may bring the items mentioned, but they are responsible for their safe-keeping.
