I grew up in an average American “Jewish/Christian” home in a suburb of New York City. Meaning that we rarely attended synagogue or church, we placed a Menorah in front of the Christmas tree, and we had a religiously segregated extended family. The day after my Bar Mitzvah (that Jewish celebration of manhood at the age of 13), I re-classified myself as an atheist because I felt that all religion was empty, greedy, and hypocritical. My struggles with religion drove me away from God, but my desire for relationship brought me to my knees before Him. But before I was willing to bow my knees, heart, and will before our beloved God, I had to experience life without Him to understand the consequences of rejecting Him. Life without Him—from failed relationships to New Age cults and from sinful lifestyles to suicidal thoughts—ended in January 1996 when I finally found real relationship with a loving and patient Savior.

Calvary Chapel Texarkana is a church plant located in Nash, Texas, and we have been involved in presenting this ministry opportunity since Spring 2005. The Lord has used this ministry to deeply touch the hearts and lives of those who have attended, and our prayer is that He will continue to do so until He calls us home.

Experiencing a Passover Seder is a blessed opportunity that we can enjoy knowing the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

REGISTRATION

Registration is required, and seating is limited—please register early. The cost of the Seder is \$15 per person. There are no profits made from the event, as all funds are used to provide for the dinner and the materials for the Seder.

The Seder lasts approximately three hours, with some periods of reading, meditation, eating, and worship. Children who will not be able to sit that long should probably not participate at this time.

Dress for the event is semi-formal. Tradition calls for the men to wear white shirts, but not necessarily dress shirts (but definitely not plain tee shirts either).
