General Job Description

The Student Ministries Pastor is one who is gifted and is called to student ministry, loves young people, and has a passion for evangelism, outreach, and missions both personally and at the ministry level within a multi-generational church setting.

Responsibilities

- Create and cast vision for Student Ministries, consistent with CCC's mission, values and statement of faith
- Primary teacher for both middle school and high school students
- Lead and influence the planning, teaching, developing of curriculum, and execution of student worship services and weekly small groups
- Be strategic about recruiting, equipping, training and empowering volunteers to shepherd students and thrive in their roles
- Create and influence a discipleship system that moves students through an intentional engagement pathway
- Meet with volunteers, parents and students for one-on-one counsel and development
- Develop the gifts and talents of students and volunteers and give them ownership to serve in the youth ministry as well as the life of the church
- Oversee the weekly Small Group ministry
- Propose, steward and administer annual budget for ministry
- Initiate, develop and maintain strong relational community connections with unchurched students, area schools, sports leagues, organizations, etc.
- Coordinate, plan and staff all student ministry trips and events
- Grow yourself in leadership, be a lifelong learner

Qualifications

- Exhibits a growing relationship with God and a teachable spirit
- Maintains a high moral and ethical lifestyle
- The minimum requirements are a Bachelor's degree in a related field from a 4-year college or university; or 1-2 years related training; or equivalent combination of education and training
- Requires 2-5 years of related experience. Related experience would be working with middle school and high school students, experience teaching, managing people and leading volunteers
- Strong leader, intentional, reliable, energetic, strategic, visionary, encouraging, personable, loves students and their families, strong communicator, relational, team player, friendly and possesses a positive attitude
