Tapawingo Social Media Policy for Parents

In accordance with the Tapawingo mission statement, Tapawingo has adopted a social media policy to protect staff, campers, and parents. To promote Christ-centered relationships in a safe and friendly manner, Tapawingo has adopted a policy which requires parental permission for campers under the age of 18 to stay in contact with staff members through their individual social media channels (e.g. Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter, etc.). Tapawingo has a social media presence through Facebook and Instagram, to provide public information about camp activities and opportunities. In order to maintain camper privacy and to maximize the camp experience, Tapawingo and CAMP-of-the-WOODS' public social media sites will not post personal pictures of campers. However, the Tapawingo Website and brochures will include pictures of campers with expressed written parental permission obtained through the photo release waiver. Staff members are instructed not to accept personal "friend" or "follower" requests from campers without parental consent. Staff members will be provided with a list of campers who are allowed to "friend" or "follow" them on social media sites and have been instructed not to accept requests from campers whose names do not appear on the list.
