March has been a very productive month as I got to pray with a Haitian man to receive Christ and am currently meeting with him and his friends for a Bible Study that we are praying eventually turns into a church! He will be baptized soon as well! My Dominican family, the Ceballos, have been traveling around Illinois for the entire month preaching, teaching, and promoting ministry in the DR. I hope you all had a chance to meet them.

My Spanish is slowly getting better. Please pray for me in that area, because I'm really struggling with understanding and listening to the language. But, I know Christ can do all things through me, so it's only a matter of time. Also pray for the young leaders and families that I'm working with here. I would like to see all the families here praying and reading Scripture together daily. I would also like to see the people in the church grow in their knowledge of the Bible and doctrine. So, pray for all the families and leaders here to be able to participate in the clinics and classes I'll be providing.

My greatest need right now is Study Bibles. After searching all the Christian bookstores in Santiago, I found only one quality study Bible. There is just not much here. If anyone is interested, you can purchase Spanish study Bibles on the internet and have them sent to Capital City Baptist Association, 1425 Stevenson Drive, Springfield, 62703. Please search for "Biblia de Estudio NVI". You can buy them used from Amazon for between \$25-\$45.
