Message 5: Eros Love

Try to list 5 things the Bible says that you think annoy people. Share your list with the group.

Has something in the Bible ever annoyed you?

What do you think the phrase "to have and to hold, from this day forward" means in the wedding vows?

"This is not my body. I don't own me and you don't own you." How do you think someone who is not a Jesus follower feels about this statement?

Read 1 Corinthians 6:19, 20. Why should a Jesus follower try to live out the above statement from question 5?

Read 1 Corinthians 7:1-6. What should these verses mean for our marriages?

3 societal perspectives on sex were mentioned: it's a natural appetite, it's a necessary evil and it's a form of self-expression. How are each of these perspectives contrary to God's perspective on sex?

Read Genesis 2:18-25. In this passage, we read phrases such as "united to" and "one flesh". What do you think God has in mind with this idea of "oneness"?
