

## Revealed | Discussion Questions September 9, 2015

Football has started. Are you a football fan? Who's your favorite college and pro football team?

What kind of sports fan are you? How do you react when you are watching a game?

"The book of Revelation tells the story with pictures, symbols and metaphors. The future is beyond our words and beyond our imagination." How does this statement from the sermon help you understand the book of Revelation?

Read Romans 8:18. How would you live your life if you knew that you win in the end?

Read Revelation 19:11-21.

In Revelation 19:12, it says "...and on his head were many crowns." On day, every person will be under the authority of Jesus. Is there an area of life that is difficult to place under his authority?

Read Rev. 19:11, Rev. 20:11, 12, Acts 10:42, 2 Cor. 5:10 and John 5:22. Knowing life here on earth is no fair. What does it mean to know that Jesus is going to set everything right as a just judge?

What does this phrase mean: "Right now God is so restrained, so veiled that it is almost maddening"?

Which of the 3 pictures of Jesus helps you the most from today's sermon: warrior, judge or father?

Try to describe what heaven will be like? After you have shared, read Revelation 21:3 and 22:1-5.

How have the pictures of Jesus in the book of Revelation shaped your faith?

As Christians, what can we do to continue to grow bigger to God, so that He will continue to grow bigger to us?
