What purpose(s) did Jesus have in dying on the cross and being resurrected for you?

What do you think the enemy, Satan, wants for you?

Read John 10:10.

- A. What is the goal of "the thief"? Who is "the thief"?
- B. Who does "they" referred to in this passage?
- C. When Jesus refers to "life", is he referring to this life or eternal life?

In Luke 15, Jesus tells a bunch of stories about lost things. What are the items that get lost in the stories and why do you think Jesus emphasizes lost things?

Read Luke 15:11-24. What is one aspect of this story that stands out to you?

God does some of his greatest miracles when we are in a pigpen.

- A. Do you agree with the statement?
- B. Share a time when God has done something good when you were in the pigpen?

Read Romans 8:28. What does this verse mean to you?

Luke 15:1-2 identifies the people who were listening to Jesus.

- A. Who were the groups of people?
- B. How do you think each group responded to the "lost" stories?
- C. How do the "lost" stories affect you?

How difficult is it to be honest about the difficulties in your life with other people?

The sermon mentioned 4 principles we need to get. Which is most difficult for you?

- A. God still loves you when you make poor choices.
- B. God still loves you when you sale, even when you're in the middle of a pigpen.
- C. God loves you while he is waiting for you to come home.
- D. God does not love you because you are good, he loves you because he is perfectly good. He is no ordinary Father.
