6. "We don't measure rich by what we have; we measure rich by what we don't have." Do you agree with this statement? If so, why do we do this?
7. Read 1 Timothy 6:9-10 and Matthew 6:24. What do you learn from these verses about money?
8. The sermon offered 3 ways to respond to your richness: Greed, Guilt and Gratitude. What is one step you can take to move toward gratitude?
9. One of the goals of this sermon was to get you to admit that you are rich. Did it work? Do you believe you are rich?
