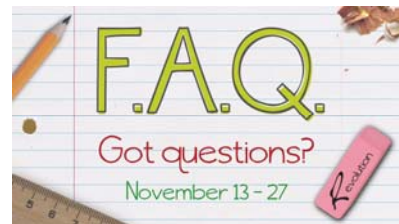
Welcome to Capital Community Church!
