

Pray for Missionary Kids

1. Pray for a strong Christian family.
 - a. That the family would spend time together and that each member would be nurtured.
 - b. That parents would encourage their children & involve them in ministry often.

Pray for Missionary Kids

2. Pray that the missionary kids would establish their own spiritual lives.
 - a. That each one would be filled with the Holy Ghost & walk with Him daily.
 - b. That they would reach out to the lost while overseas.
 - c. That they would be strong in Christ, an example, mature, faithful (1 Tim 4:12)
 - d. That they would have a hunger for God's Word.
 - e. That they would not be dependent on their flesh but seek God's strength & power.
 - f. That they would have a thankful heart for all of God's blessings.
 - g. That they would keep their priorities straight and God would put a call on them.
 - h. That they would find God's will and be protected from bad influences.

Pray for Missionary Kids

3. Pray for emotional stability & personal growth.
 - a. For victory over feelings of isolation from friends and family at home.
 - b. For strength when they must be separated to attend school or college.
 - c. That they would be sorry they are MKs or harbor bitterness, revenge, retaliation.
 - d. That they would have good mentors and discuss problems, doubts, fear, confusion.
 - e. That they would have empathy with the nationals of the country where they live.

Pray for Missionary Kids

4. Pray for their education
 - a. That God would provide an opportunity for them to receive a good education.
 - b. For their academic, social, emotional, physical & spiritual needs (Luke 2:52).
 - c. That God would guide them concerning schooling, career and life partner.

Pray for Missionary Kids

5. Pray for the missionary kids to seize opportunities presented them as MKs.
 - a. That MKs would seize the possibilities to learn and grow from their foreign experiences.

Pray for Missionary Kids

6. Pray for MKs as they reenter the homeland.
 - a. That God would direct their choices and provide for financial needs.
 - b. That God would send people to support them - an adopted extended family
 - c. That they would conduct themselves according to God's Word and not the world.
 - d. That they would use their language/foreign culture skills to work in ethnic ministries among foreign college students in North America.

Pray for Children

"Children are an heritage of the Lord." Psalm 127:3

1. Pray for the children of the world.
 - a. Pray for innocent children brought into families bound by drugs, idolatry, etc.
 - b. Pray for the Lord to send laborers into nations where children are in bad situations.
 - c. Pray for children around the world to be filled with God's spirit.
 - d. Pray for children around the world who are mistreated, abused and led into false teachings unless they are reached with truth.

Pray for Children

2. Pray for your children & your friends' children.
 - a. Pray for their salvation.
 - b. Pray that God will strengthen their weaknesses in spiritual things.
 - c. Pray that they will use their talents & gifts for the glory of God and His kingdom.
 - d. Pray for their health, safety & protection.

Pray for Children

"Children are an heritage of the Lord." Psalm 127:3

3. Pray for the children of leaders.
 - a. Pray for your church leaders' children (pastors, ministers, Sunday School teachers).
 - b. Pray for local, provincial/state & national leaders' children.

Pray for Children

4. Pray for your neighborhood children.
 - a. Pray for problems in your neighborhood. Prayer will make a difference!
 - b. Pray for neighborhood bullies.
 - c. Pray that God will give you love for these children.
 - d. Pray for the salvation of community children.
 - e. Pray for influence and that your church can connect with these children & their families.

Pray for Your Pastor

1. Why you should pray for your pastor.
 - a. Love: "Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ." Galatians 6:2. You help bear the burden of ministry when you pray for him. You are showing love for him and obeying the greatest commandment - the law of love.
 - b. Humility: It focuses on his needs and breaks the chains of pride that keep so many people from becoming what they could be for God. You are practicing submission.
 - c. Unity: Praying for him will bind your heart together with his. When you unite with your pastor and his vision for your church and city, you become a vessel God can use.

Pray for Your Pastor

3. Pray for personal prayer needs of your pastor: Relationships.
 - a. That he would not be corrupted by the necessary contact with a sinful world and that his heart would withstand the influences of his worldly acquaintances.
 - b. That he would influence every person he meets for good and that he would be a shining witness for Christ.
 - c. For peace in his dealings with people (family, friends, business associates, church members). Disharmony can produce a great deal of unnecessary stress.

Pray for Your Pastor

5. Pray for family prayer needs of your pastor: Relationships.
 - a. That the peace of God would cover and protect the fabric of his family.
 - b. That God's anointing would ease the friction and produce a loving atmosphere.
 - c. That he would be the godly leader of his home, giving his family the love and attention they need to grow.
 - d. That his income would meet the needs and realistic desires of his family.

Pray for Your Pastor

7. Pray for spiritual prayer needs of your pastor: Power.
 - a. That he would be energized by the Holy Ghost for his daily pastoral duties.
 - b. That he would be strong in the Lord and the power of His might and that he would be prepared to do all things through Christ who strengthens him (Philippians 4:13).

Pray for Your Pastor

9. Pray for spiritual prayer needs of your pastor: Accountability.
 - a. That he would have a pastor of his own.
 - b. Pray that he will remain open to such a friendship.

Pray for Your Pastor

2. Pray for personal prayer needs of your pastor: Humility.
 - a. That he would walk humbly with God, seeking His will and direction in all things (Micah 6:8).
 - b. That his heart would be strong in the midst of trials and accusation and that he would commit himself into God's hands.
 - c. That he would learn and grow through every circumstance and give God glory for every victory. Pray that he would give thanks in all things.

Pray for Your Pastor

4. Pray for personal prayer needs of your pastor: Balance.
 - a. That he would maintain a steady, consistent walk and that he would not be swayed by dangerous extremes. That his course would be steadfast and unwavering.
 - b. That his character would combine the strength and gentleness of the Lord - the Lion and the Lamb.

Pray for Your Pastor

6. Pray for personal prayer needs of your pastor: Protection.
 - a. That his family would be protected from Satan's attacks.
 - b. Pray against negative pressures and distractions.
 - c. Pray that as your pastor abides in the presence of God that no destructive force would touch his home and that God's angels would keep his family (Psalm 91:9-11).

Pray for Your Pastor

8. Pray for spiritual prayer needs of your pastor: Holiness.
 - a. Pray for a hedge of purity around your pastor. Cover his eyes, his mind, his steps and his heart with holiness that he wouldn't fall into the temptation and snares of the Devil.
 - b. For his words to be seasoned with grace and for his mind to be stayed on the Lord.
 - c. Pray that he would be well pleasing in all things to God.

Pray for Your Pastor

10. Pray for spiritual prayer needs of your pastor: Warfare.
 - a. Pray the armor of God over your pastor (Ephesians 6:10-18).
 - b. Pray scriptures for his protection (Psalm 91, Luke 19:10, etc.).
 - c. Pray that no weapon formed against him would prosper (Isaiah 54:17).
 - d. Pray that he would not be ignorant of the enemy's devices and that the enemy would not gain an advantage over him (2 Corinthians 2:11).

Pray for Your Pastor

11. Pray for leadership & church work prayer needs of your pastor: In the City.
 - a. That God's people would be called from every corner of you area and be gathered together to your pastor.
 - b. Pray that everyone that God has ordained to ministry will come and submit themselves to him (Psalm 18:44).
 - c. Pray that he would be an anointed leader in your community.

Pray for Your Pastor

12. Pray for leadership & church work prayer needs of your pastor: Pulpit Ministry.
 - a. That God's anointing would rest heavily upon your pastor and that God would prepare him for that anointing.
 - b. That the Word of God would come alive as he preaches.
 - c. That a burning conviction would grip the hearts of everyone - saints and sinners alike - that is not right with God.
 - d. That his study and preparation time would be protected so that he can receive from God the message He has for your church.
 - e. That his preaching would magnify Christ & Christ would draw all men unto Himself.

Pray for Your Pastor

13. Pray for leadership & church work prayer needs of your pastor: Vision.
 - a. That he would receive God's direction and vision for your church.
 - b. That he would be sensitive to the needs of the congregation as he leads and that he would feed the flock that which they have need of.

Pray for Your Pastor

14. Pray for leadership & church work prayer needs of your pastor: Counseling.
 - a. That God's wisdom would flow through your pastor as he deals with the problems of people.
 - b. That he would be protected from the pressure of sinful, negative and antagonistic spirits that he may encounter during counseling.
 - c. That he would be anointed to give beauty for ashes and the oil of gladness for those that mourn (Isaiah 61:3).

Pray for Your Pastor

15. Pray for leadership & church work prayer needs of your pastor: Finances.
 - a. That he would have wisdom in handling the church's finances and the strength to bear the pressure of financial responsibilities.
 - b. That God would bless your church that you might be the head and not the tail.
 - c. That the church's stewardship over money would glorify God and help establish the work of God in your city.

Pray for Home Missions

1. Pray for a specific home missionary's relationship with God.
 - a. That he/she would love and study God's Word.
 - b. That he/she would have a strong prayer life.
 - c. That he/she would be continually filled with the Holy Ghost.
 - d. That he/she would continue to mature spiritually.
 - e. That he/she would make progress over personal sin.

Pray for Home Missions

2. Pray for a specific home missionary's physical and emotional needs.
 - a. That he/she would have financial stability.
 - b. That he/she would have peace of mind.
 - c. That he/she would have good morale in the midst of hardship.
 - d. That he/she would have stamina, safety and a sense of priority.
 - e. Pray preventatively for their health.
 - f. Pray against discouragement, loneliness and depression.

Pray for Home Missions

3. Pray for a specific home missionary's family relationships.
 - a. That the children would be saved, grow spiritually, have good health and education.
 - b. That the family would provide an excellent model local Christians and the unsaved.
 - c. Pray against temptations that destroy families.
 - d. That the home missionary would maintain good relationships with the home church, parents and family members at home.

Pray for Home Missions

4. Pray for a specific home missionary's ability to communicate.
 - a. That your home missionary would be an anointed preacher, a sound Bible teacher, a dedicated soulwinner and an excellent communicator.
 - b. That he/she would adjust to a different ethnicity/culture they are trying to reach. Pray that they would have the stamina and understanding to demonstrate Christ cross-culturally.

Pray for Home Missions

5. Pray for a specific home missionary's effective ministry.
 - a. That he/she would have success with people when witnessing, visiting, teaching, preaching, counseling, nurturing, etc.
 - b. Pray for boldness, open doors, open hearts, excellence in the effort.
 - c. Ask that the Holy Ghost empower your home missionary's productivity (John 15:16).

Pray for Home Missions

6. Pray for a specific home missionary's team relationships.
 - a. That the home missionaries would be and have team members who sharpen and appreciate one another.

Pray for Home Missions

7. Pray for a specific home missionary's state or province of service.
 - a. That the whole region will become more open and responsive to the gospel.

Pray for Christian Leadership

1. Pray for leadership: Favor with God.
 - a. That they would walk in the spirit and be pleasing to the Lord.
 - b. That the Holy Spirit would give personal direction, teaching and vision.
 - c. That their knowledge of God would be ever-increasing.
 - d. That they would work to be the best.
 - e. That they would have strength to withstand fiery tests.

Pray for Christian Leadership

2. Pray for leadership: Favor with Man.
 - a. That people will be sensitive to financial needs of leaders and support them.
 - b. That there will be no gossip, deceit or unbelief.
 - c. That God will send his ministering angels to guard the leaders.
 - d. That all leaders will be in unity and attuned to the Holy Spirit for direction, supportive of one another.
 - e. That God will give leaders a spirit of wisdom, understanding, knowledge, counsel, strength, and an obedient and reverent fear of the Lord (Isaiah 11:2).
 - f. That leaders will witness boldly and that those hearts would be open to the Gospel.

Pray for Christian Leadership

3. Pray for leadership: Pure Vision.
 - a. That God would clarify his vision for ministry to the leaders.
 - b. That there would be sufficient helpers to carry out the vision.
 - c. For keen discernment between God's wisdom and human wisdom.
 - d. For pure motives, purged by God through the Word and their personal prayer time.
 - e. For discernment against impure motives.
 - f. For God to lead and direct their paths.

Pray for Christian Leadership

4. Pray for leadership: Spirit, Soul & Body.
 - a. Pray for divine health: physically, mentally, emotionally and spiritually.
 - b. For effects of tiredness/discouragement to be loosed from their minds and bodies.
 - c. That the Fruit of the Spirit would work in their lives (Galatians 5:22-23).
 - d. That they would be totally submitted to God in every area of life.
 - e. For a spirit of unity, not competition; humility, not superiority; cooperation, not defensiveness.
 - f. That they would pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace.
 - g. That leaders would feed daily on the Word of God and maintain a faithful prayer life.

Pray for Christian Leadership

5. Pray for leadership: Warfare and Protection.
 - a. That God would send angels to guard leaders' families, property, all that is going in, coming out, the air above, the ground below.
 - b. That angels would go before them and do battle on their behalf.
 - c. That God foils all attacks and traps of the enemy.
 - d. Against all occult activity - curses, witchcraft, sorcery.

Pray for Christian Leadership

6. Pray for leadership: Priorities.
 - a. That the Lord will cause the leaders to abound in prosperity - body, soul and spirit.
 - b. Thank God for providing all the needs - personal, family and ministry.
 - c. For leaders to be wise stewards of time, to become disciplined.
 - d. For leaders' relationship with God to always remain top priority.

Pray for Christian Leadership

7. Pray for leadership: Family.
 - a. For unity and understanding among family members.
 - b. That there would be no resentment when sacrifice is required.
 - c. For God to meet the emotional needs.
 - d. That leaders would spend quality time with their families - leisure and spiritual time.
 - e. For the family to discern each other's needs - emotional, physical, material, spiritual.
 - f. For them to overcome pressures and stress.
 - g. That the children will be free from expectations put on them that are not in line with God's will.

Pray for Evangelists

1. When praying for evangelists, pray..
 - a. That they would have the mind of Christ. That they would put on the helmet of salvation. That they would be protected. Isaiah 43:2, Psalm 91:4-11
 - b. That they would hear the voice of the Lord and see with eyes of the Spirit.
 - c. That they would speak the Word with the power of God's anointing (Luke 21:14-15, Ephesians 6:18, Jeremiah 1:7, Colossians 3:16, 4:3)
 - d. That their hearts would be pure before God (Psalm 24:4).
 - e. That their innermost being would flow with the Spirit (John 7:38).

Pray for Evangelists

2. When praying for evangelists, pray...
 - a. That their strength would be increased and their health protected (Psalm 1:3).
 - b. That their knees would bend with anointed prayer and intercession and multitudes would be saved.
 - c. That their hands and feet would be guided by the Holy Ghost to do the work of the kingdom of God.
 - d. That they would be endowed with both academic and spiritual wisdom, knowledge and understanding (Proverbs 2:6).
 - e. That they would have God's abundant joy (Ecclesiastes 2:26).

Pray for Evangelists

3. When praying for evangelists, pray...
 - a. That they would be used in continual demonstration of the Spirit and power of God (1 Corinthians 2:12-13).
 - b. That the gift of faith would operate through them (2 Thessalonians 1:11).
 - c. That they would be blessed with power over all the enemy (Luke 10:19).
 - d. That God would bless them with divine favor and many would be saved (1 Peter 3:12).
 - e. That God would give them favor with all people and many doors of opportunity would be open to preach God's truths (Acts 2:47).

Pray for Evangelists

4. When praying for evangelists, pray...
 - a. That they would be protected against unbelief (Romans 15:30).
 - b. That God would bless them with spiritual understanding and fruitfulness (Ephesians 3:4-6).
 - c. That their income would always be sufficient to pay their monthly expenses and any emergency expense (Philippians 4:19).
 - d. That their income would permit them to minister to congregations with very limited funds (Philippians 4:19).
 - e. That their home would be blessed.

Pray for Evangelists

5. When praying for evangelists, pray...
 - a. That they would be blessed with a vehicle that works well.
 - b. That they would always have adequate clothing, shelter, household supplies and food.
 - c. That they would have the tools necessary to minister.

Pray for Youth

1. Pray for an abiding, personal relationship with Christ (John 15:5).
 - a. That youth would commit their lives to Christ, be filled with His spirit and be baptized in His name.
 - b. That they would recognize that His name is above every other name (Acts 4:12) and confess by a life fully submitted to divine authority that He is Lord of all (Philippians 2:11).
 - c. That they would learn to communicate with Christ and learn to depend on Him for everything.
 - d. That they would understand the depth of God's love for them (1 John 3:1).

Pray for Youth

2. Pray for an abiding, personal relationship with Christ.
 - a. That they would base their self-esteem and identity in Christ and not the standards of the world.
 - b. That they would know who they are, what they have in Christ, and what they can do through Him (Colossians 1:27, Ephesians 1:4, 7, 11-14).
 - c. That they would be blessed with the joy that comes from knowing Christ.
 - d. That they would be filled so completely with the joy of the Lord that they would not pursue worldly pleasures (Romans 14:17, Psalm 16:11, Philippians 4:4, Nehemiah 8:10).

Pray for Youth

3. Pray for moral purity (Psalm 51:7-10).
 - a. That they would develop the strength of character to remain morally pure.
 - b. That they would make the right decisions about sex, drugs and worldly pleasures.
 - c. That they would defeat negative peer pressure and learn to make right choices.
 - d. That they would have a pure heart.
 - e. That they would not just keep a set of rules, but desire to please God in all they do.
 - f. That they'd be wise in what is good & innocent and what is evil (Psalm 119: 127-130).
 - g. That the Word of God would be instilled in their hearts and that they would choose the obedience of hating sin and loving His holiness.

Pray for Youth

4. Pray for values and relationships.
 - a. That they would retain values that made our nations/churches great (Titus 2:11-14).
 - b. That they would develop friendships based on the drawing of the Holy Spirit.
 - c. That God would give them friends who are true, wholesome, mutually encouraging.
 - d. That they'd have wisdom to choose relationships that honor God (Psalm 119:63).
 - e. That they would set their thoughts on what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent and worthy of praise (Philippians 4:8, John 8:32, Romans 12:2).

Pray for Youth

5. Pray for mission-mindedness (Mark 16:15-16).
 - a. That they would accept their divine mission in life - to be a witness for Jesus Christ and disciple others (Acts 1:8).
 - b. That they would become spiritual leaders and boldly, courageously stand up for what they believe and cherish (1 Timothy 4:12).
 - c. That they would become the catalyst for revival in their churches, schools and communities and accept roles of responsibility in these areas.
 - d. That they would take their place in God's kingdom.

Pray for National Ministers

1. Pray for their personal needs.
 - a. That they would be godly, govern their spirits in accordance with God's Word, know self-control and produce the fruit of the Spirit.
 - b. That they would be clothed with the garment of praise instead of a spirit of depression and that they would be an oak of righteousness (Isaiah 61:3).

Pray for National Ministers

2. Pray for their family needs.
 - a. That he would be the husband/father his family needs and deserves, sensitive to their needs and an example of piety and devotion.
 - b. That he would love his wife and rear his children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
 - c. That he, his wife and children would be willing to make whatever sacrifice is demanded for the sake of the kingdom of God.
 - d. That his children would receive His spirit (Acts 2:39).

Pray for National Ministers

3. Pray for their financial needs.
 - a. That God would meet their financial needs (Philippians 4:19); that they would have comfortable lodging, sufficient clothing, a well-balanced diet.
 - b. That they would have transportation for their personal needs and the needs of the ministry.
 - c. Pray that their children would have educational opportunities.

Pray for National Ministers

4. Pray for their physical and health needs.
 - a. That God would strengthen him and give he and his family good health.
5. Pray for their ministry needs.
 - a. That the anointing of the Holy Ghost would rest upon the national minister. (2 Peter 1:8).

Pray for National Ministers

6. Pray for their leadership needs.
 - a. That he would have favor with people - both in the church and without.
 - b. That he would have wisdom and understanding to lead his people.
 - c. That God would open doors of ministry that no one, not even a governmental official, can close (Revelation 3:8).

Pray for Bible School Students & Teachers

1. Pray they will...
 - a. Act justly, love mercy and walk humbly with God (Micah 6:8).
 - b. Hunger and thirst for righteousness (Matthew 5:6).
 - c. Hunger for the Word of God (Psalm 119:103).
 - d. Recognize that God alone gives wisdom, understanding and knowledge (Psalm 111:10).
 - e. Possess the wisdom and discernment necessary to meet the tasks before them (1 Kings 3:12).
 - f. Hate evil, love good and maintain a relationship with God (Amos 5:14).

Pray for Bible School Students & Teachers

2. Pray they will...
 - a. Maintain an attitude of humility, always mindful of those they are serving (1 Peter 5:5).
 - b. Be on guard, stand firm in the faith, and be men and women of courage (1 Corinthians 16:13).
 - c. Consider purity and truth their highest calling (1 Timothy 4:16).
 - d. Allow truth to prevail and strongholds of confusion and deception to be exposed (Philippians 4:8-9).
 - e. Be surrounded by the Lord's favor and protection (Psalm 5:12).

Pray for Bible School Students & Teachers

3. Pray they will...
 - a. Be teachers who are exemplary role models in speech, conduct and doctrine (Proverbs 3:1-12).
 - b. Nurture children in godly traditions, teaching respect for the dignity of life (Ephesians 6:4).
 - c. Not succumb to peer pressure, but rather set an example in speech, love and purity (1 Timothy 4:12).
 - d. Humble themselves and lead us forth in the healing of our land (2 Chronicles 7:14).

Pray for Missionaries

1. Pray for the missionaries' personal needs. Call their name in prayer.
 - a. For the missionary children; call them by name.
 - b. For the missionary's personal relationship with God.
 - c. For their physical and emotional needs. For good health.
 - d. Against emotional distress such as discouragement, depression, loneliness and homesickness.
 - e. That they can make the necessary adjustments to living in their of labor.
 - f. For protection as they travel.

Pray for Missionaries

2. Pray for the effective ministry of the missionaries. The Lord is able to open locked doors.
 - a. That there would be revival in each nation and region of the world.
 - b. That the missionaries would be effective soulwinners. That they would be free to preach the gospel and that people would be responsive to the message.
 - c. That they can communicate the gospel to a people who may have never heard it. That they would have boldness and spiritual understanding in dealing with the people to whom they are ministering.
 - d. That God's love would fill their hearts for the people they are trying to win.
 - e. That God's anointing would rest on them and their efforts.

Pray for Missionaries

3. Pray for the missionary's family, that they would be knit together.
 - a. That there would be unity among the missionary families involved in reaching this country and the national pastors and ministers.
 - b. That the Lord would help them develop good national leaders that will multiply their efforts. May their burden become the burden of the national workers.

Pray for Missionaries

4. Pray for the nation where the missionaries work.
 - a. That they would find favor in the eyes of those in high places that can help further the kingdom.
 - b. For any special meetings in the country such as revivals, crusades or conferences.
 - c. For the establishment of a strong national church and for the national leaders and ministers as they carry out the great commission.
 - d. For national Bible Schools - the students, teachers and support staff.

Pray for Missionaries

5. Pray for the time when missionaries are in the homeland.
 - a. That they would be protected.
 - b. That they would quickly raise all their needed funds and be able to return to the field as soon as possible.
 - c. That those left in charge would be successful with their responsibilities.

Pray for Missionaries

6. Consider the following when praying for missionaries.
 - a. Pray with fasting and you will break down Satan's strongholds.
 - b. Pray believing (Mark 11:24) and with confidence that you are making a difference (James 5:16).
 - c. Praise God for answered prayers.
 - d. Praise Him in advance of prayers He is going to answer.
 - e. Focus prayer on a specific missionary and family.
 - f. Pray consistently, no matter how many times you have failed in prayer commitments. You can always begin again! Do not be discouraged!

Pray for Your Nation

1. Pray for the president or prime minister, his cabinet members and his advisors.
 - a. That he would have the moral and political courage to do what is best for the nation.
 - b. That he would set high moral and ethical standards of conduct for himself and those associated with him, setting an example for other world leaders to follow.
 - c. That he would surround himself with people of integrity and godly wisdom.
 - d. That he would have a "Daniel" to reveal the things of God to him.

Pray for Your Nation

2. Pray for the Supreme Court.
 - a. That the justices would be just and upright in their decisions.
 - b. That the Holy Spirit would give them wisdom and insight.
 - c. That men and women of high moral character and sharp, legal minds would be added to the bench as the older justices are replaced.

Pray for Your Nation

3. Pray for Congress or Parliament.
 - a. That people of integrity and moral character would be elected to these chambers.
 - b. That they would have the strength to withstand political corruption.
 - c. That they would have vision and wisdom to pass the laws to promote domestic tranquility while keeping the nation safe internationally.

Pray for Your Nation

4. Pray for the governor or premier and state or provincial officials.
 - a. That they would seek what is best for the state or province and not what is just politically expedient to satisfy lobbyists.
 - b. That they would be of high moral character, sensitive to divine leadership and strong enough to resist political corruption.

Pray for Your Nation

5. Pray for county commissioners, mayors, city council.
 - a. That that would seek the good of the city and county and not just their own.
 - b. That they would be men and women of morality and integrity with strength of character.
 - c. That they would promote peace and tranquility in the communities.
 - d. That they would help establish an environment that helps the church fulfill its commission.
 - e. That the city's laws and ordinances would not hinder the growth of the church as it seeks to reach out to the lost and build new facilities.

Pray for Your Nation

6. Pray for civil service personnel that protect and service our communities.
 - a. That God would protect them and keep them safe that we all may live in security and peace.

Pray for Families

 - a. That God would anoint and inspire the teachers to reach and teach the children on their level.
 - b. That children's hearts would be tender toward the Lord.
 - c. That they would receive the Holy Ghost in classrooms and kids church services.

3. Pray for unity of purpose among...
 - a. All involved in helping bring revival.
 - b. Those teaching Bible studies.
 - c. Those witnessing and teaching.
 - d. Those receiving Bible studies and teaching.

Pray for Revival

4. Pray for...
 - a. Your nation, state or province, county, city and communities (1 Timothy 2:1-2).
 - b. A great outpouring of the Holy Ghost today (Joel 2:28, Acts 2:39).
 - c. Many signs, wonders, and miracles today (Mark 16:17).
 - d. A great drawing of the Spirit today (Revelation 22:17).
 - e. The soulwinners, that they will be led to hungry people who are ready to harvest (Luke 10:2).
