### **CONTEMPORARY CHRISTIANS** - ROOM 233

The class will feature a variety of formats: video discussions, outside speakers, topics from "THE WIRED WORD" on-line, book discussions, biblical studies and topics suggested by the class. Getting to know one another in a relaxed and casual setting is a bonus of this class! We will begin the year with Chip Ingram's "Living on the Edge: Dare to Experience True Spirituality" - a powerful study of Romans 12 on what it means to be an authentic follower of Jesus Christ.
