GUIDELINES FOR DEACON/SUNDAY SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP

1. Meet the Teacher
2. Talk with the teacher and familiarize yourself with the people on the Bible Study Roll and their needs.
3. Begin by contacting class members and introducing yourself and your desire to minister to them.
4. Maintain contact with them on a regular, appropriate interval.
5. Maintain a relationship with the Teacher to ensure that all needs are being met and the Deacon/Teacher relationship is harmonious.
6. Give the Deacon Board a monthly update on the status and well-being of the class members.
7. The Bible Study Teacher is the sole authority over his/her class.
8. The Deacon is a support to the Teacher.
9. The Deacon should show initiative in supporting the Teacher.
10. The Deacon Family Ministry should never become a burden to the Teacher.
