





Zechariah 9:9:

"Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, your King is coming to you;
He is just and having salvation,
Lowly and riding on a donkey,
A colt, the foal of a donkey.

f. The Receiving of a Kingdom. (v.12)

A. The Nobleman by Birth.

- It was a noble birth.
- Born of the linage of King David.

B. The Kings Presentation on Palm Sunday.

Luke 19:38, Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the LORD! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!

Verse 42, saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes."

C. The King's Rejected.

V. 47, "And He was teaching daily in the temple. But the chief priests, the scribes, and the leaders of the people sought to destroy Him..."

D. They wanted to kill the King, that was their plan.

Luke 23:23-24, But they were insistent, demanding with loud voices that He be crucified. And the voices of these men and of the chief priests prevailed.

²⁴So Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they requested.

V. 14b, 'We will not have this man to reign over us.'



E. What they didn't know was it was God's plan.

Isaiah 53:2-3, For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him.

³He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

I. The Return of the King to claim His Kingdom (V.12).

A. The King's departure preparing for His return.

"Do business till I come" (V.13) - KJV - Occupy till I come.

First: His servants must give an account

Second: His enemies will give an account

V.27, But bring here those enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, and slay them before me".

B. The triumphal entry began at the Mt. of Olives. (Vv.29-44)

V. 37-38, Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen, ³⁸saying: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!' Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

C. The Kingdom will come when the King returns.

- Ezekiel 43:1-2 & 4: Afterward he brought me to the gate, the gate that faces toward the east.
- ²And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east. His voice was like the sound of many waters; and the earth shone with His glory.
- V.4 the glory of the Lord came into the temple by way of the gate which faces toward the east.
- Ezekiel 44: 1-2: Then He brought me back to the outer gate of the sanctuary which faces toward the east, but it was shut.
- ²And the Lord said to me, "This gate shall be shut; it shall not be opened, and no man shall enter by it, because the Lord God of Israel has entered by it; therefore it shall be shut.

D. The future triumphal entry.

Zechariah 14:3-4, Then the Lord will go forth and fight against those nations, As He fights in the day of battle.

⁴ And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, Which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, from east to west, making a very large valley; half of the mountain shall move toward the north and half of it toward the south.

Revelation 19:11: Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

III. The Responsibility of the King's Servants (v.13)

A. "Occupy till I come;"- "Do business till I come"

Acts 1:11, who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

John 14:3, And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

B. This is also His command to you and me.

Do business till I come.

The King is coming!

The King is on His way!

C. We are to seize each moment to serve Him.

D. All will Give an account when the King comes.

"We will not have this man rule over us" (V.14).

John 1:10-13, He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

- ¹¹He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.
- ¹²But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:
- ¹³who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.
