Haitian Earthquake Response

Haiti has been hit with a devastating earthquake and the C&MA in Canada will be participating in relief efforts through partner Christian Relief and Development agencies. We do not have International Workers in Haiti but there are Alliance churches in Haiti. Here are prayer requests to assist you in praying for the situation:

1. Security and Safety. The looting and violence that takes place in the aftermath of one of these disasters is a huge concern right now.
2. Post Traumatic Stress. We have reports that there are people crying as they are dying in the streets. Many, including children are watching this unfold in front of them. Pray God will guide the church and relief workers as they offer counselling and that debriefing and healing from the emotional trauma will come quickly.
3. Pray for the Church in Haiti that God will use them to communicate hope and compassion in this tragedy.
4. Pray that non-believers will be drawn to Christ through this time.
5. Pray for the Christian relief and development agencies – that there will be unity and wisdom as they assess the need and the most effective way to administer relief and subsequent reconstruction.
6. Pray for strength, safety and endurance for relief workers.
7. Pray also for our Haitian churches in Montreal who have many family members in Haiti.

How to give to the Earthquake Relief Fund:

The Government of Canada has recently announced that they will match all donations given between Jan12th and Feb 12th. You can give tax-receiptable donations to Cedarview Alliance Church through your envelopes designated to The Global Emergency Response Fund – Haiti Earthquake but in the month of January ONLY for the Government matched portion OR simply go to the Christian and Missionary National Website www.cmacan.org and on their home page click the 'Donate Now' icon. Then click Global Emergency Response Fund on the drop down. Donations to the Global Emergency Response Fund will be used to assist the victims of this earthquake in Haiti and other global emergency needs.
