

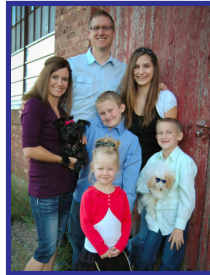
Commitments!

- ...having a JOYFUL attitude!

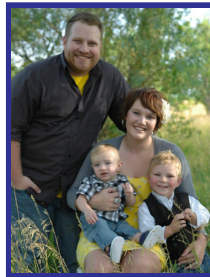

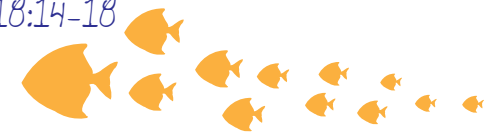

9:00am Service

Volunteers

All volunteers, please check-in at the Bay by 8:30 to get your name tag and instructions for the day. *All volunteers must wear their name tag at all times!*

Children Ages 0-5

At the check-in station, or Bay, a volunteer will escort nursery to kindergarten aged child to the appropriate classroom.

Children in 1st-5th Grade

At the check-in station, or Bay, a volunteer will escort children to their assigned classroom where they will eat a snack, play board games and visit until 9:15.

At 9:15 they will go to the Pond for Children's Church where the EMCEE will present the DVD portion of their lesson.

At 9:45 children return to their assigned classroom to complete the hands-on portion of their lesson.

After service, all children will be dismissed to their parents in the hallway.

10:45am Service

Volunteers

All volunteers, please check-in at the Bay by 10:15 to get your name tag and instructions for the day. *All volunteers must wear their name tag at all times!*

Children Ages 0-5

At the check-in station, or Bay, a volunteer will escort nursery to kindergarten aged child to the appropriate classroom.

Children in 1st-5th Grade

At the check-in station, or Bay, a volunteer will escort children to their assigned rooms where they will eat a snack, play board games and visit until 11:00.

At 11:00 they will go to the Pond for Children's Church where the EMCEE will present the DVD portion of their lesson.

At 11:30 children return to their assigned rooms to complete the hands-on portion of their lesson.

6:00pm Service

Volunteers

All volunteers, please check-in at the Bay by 5:30 to get your name tag and instructions for the day. *All volunteers must wear their name tag at all times!*

Children Ages 0-5

At the check-in station, or Bay, a volunteer will escort nursery to kindergarten aged child to the appropriate classroom.

Children in 1st-5th Grade

These children will go with their parents to church for family worship time. After two songs, the children will be dismissed and volunteers will escort them to the Room C for Children's Church where the EMCEE will present the DVD portion of their lesson. There will also be a related game to play since many children attending this service have already been to a morning service.

Security Procedures

Only GoFish volunteers with nametags are allowed in the children's hallway, classrooms and Pond. If a parent wishes to check on their child, they must go to the Bay Area to request an escort from a volunteer staff member.

After services, all children will be dismissed in the hallway. If a parent needs to pick up their child before the service is over they need to go to the Bay area.

Count, count, and count again! Please be sure you count how many kids are with you and recount to be sure they are all still there! Count before and after moving from one room to another! (bathroom, playground, etc.)

Restrooms - Children needing assistance need to use the restroom in the 2-3 year old room. Older children need to use the restrooms in the secure hallway. Please wait in the doorway with the door open to the restrooms until all children have returned to class.
