

DRESS CODE-LADIES

DRESS CODE ITEM	ACCEPTABLE	UNACCEPTABLE
Tops Necklines must be modestly cut, revealing no cleavage; must not be see-through/sheer; must not be tight/clingy; must not allow undergarments to be visible. Tank tops, halter-tops, spaghetti straps or other tops that are revealing around the neck and shoulder are not permitted unless a shirt is worn underneath or covering. Back must be fully covered. WEDNESDAY CHAPEL ATTIRE: NO T-SHIRTS OR SWEATSHIRTS	Blouse Sweater Dressy knit top Polo Shirts Sweatshirts T-shirts	T-shirts/shirts with logos, or pictures contrary to biblical principles (including bands) Shirts with skulls Undershirts Tank tops Midriff/skin visible under the shirt at any time Any item deemed immodest or sloppy
Dresses/Skirts It cannot have a low-cut neckline; display cleavage; be considered tight or clingy; be sheer to allow any underclothing to be visible, or in any other way be considered immodest, according to school authority. WEDNESDAY CHAPEL ATTIRE: ladies may wear dress slacks or skirts to the <u>ankle</u>.	A modestly cut dress or skirt is one that is meant to display femininity yet not flaunt oneself immodestly. Solid material under sheer skirts must come to the top of the knee.	Any shorter than top of the knee when standing or a having any slit that goes higher than top of the knee when standing
PANTS The cut of the slacks/pants must not allow skin (above the knee) or undergarments to be visible at any time ; must not drag the floor, or have holes. Leggings must have skirt or covering within dress code policy. WEDNESDAY CHAPEL ATTIRE: ladies may wear dress slacks or skirts to the <u>ankle</u>. Jewelry-

- Extreme amounts of jewelry should not be worn.
- A maximum of two piercings in the earlobe or 2 pieces of jewelry may be worn on the outer ear. No gages
- Other than a girl's ears, jewelry requiring body piercing may not be worn.

Hair-

- Hair must be of a natural color.

Miscellaneous-

- Bizarre or extreme makeup is not permitted.
- Tattoos are not permitted. This includes drawing on the arms and legs with ink, pencil, or marker of any kind.
- No hats or hoods will be worn inside the buildings at ANY TIME.
- Blankets, capes, and distracting accessories are not appropriate attire and are not to be brought to school.
- Outside school hours, staff and administration will enforce the dress code with students that are representing and participating in school activities (for example sporting events and school programs). However, some banquets and programs may allow specific dress, which will be enforced by the staff.

****Any infraction of the dress code will result in the student being asked to correct it before being allowed to go to class. Parents will be notified to bring a change of clothes to the office. If they are unable to do so, the school will provide clothing.**
