A Letter from Pastor BJ Brooks



The Grace of Thanksgiving

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-7)

As we approach the Thanksgiving holiday, many of us are considering all that we have to be thankful for. Our families, our health, our financial blessings, our homes, our country, our friends, our freedoms, and so much more. It only seems right to thank God for the many blessings He has bestowed upon us. As James wrote "every good and perfect gift comes from God" (James 1:17). But beyond simply giving God credit for what He's done, thanksgiving is actually beneficial for the one giving thanks — you and I.

In Philippians 4, Paul speaks to one of the human experiences that if unchecked can rob us of joy and contentment – anxiety. Anxiety is fear that predicates on being preoccupied with the uncertainties of the future. We all know what this feels like. Worrying over our finances, our jobs, our children, our health, our country, our safety, our relationships, and the list goes on and on. While a certain level of vigilance can be constructive, an obsession with what may or may not happen can paralyze us from joyful obedience to the Lord. Paul's prescription is to give our worries to the Lord through prayer and supplication and thanksgiving.

The therapeutic qualities of thanksgiving come not from simply thanking God, but also in allowing ourselves to be reminded of the ways in which God has been there for us and will continue to be. As we recognize God's providence and sovereignty over our past circumstances we come to embrace His power and care for us in the present also. The result is that we will receive peace from God that He will lead us through whatever we face, that He will care for us and protect us and enable us to benefit through any trial. This peace acts to guard our hearts and minds from further worry. This peace can surpass the weight of all our burdens and fears, making us able to face whatever the future may hold. After all, we serve and worship the One who holds the future, as well as our lives, in His hand.

As we celebrate Thanksgiving, let's be sure to do what the holiday name implies – Give Thanks. As we do so, not only will God receive the glory that He is due, but we will benefit from an assurance that His goodness and mercy will continue to guide us no matter what the future may hold.

Romans 5:9, 10 - ⁹ Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.


Ephesians 2:8, 9 - For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves **it is the gift** of God not of works, lest anyone should boast.
