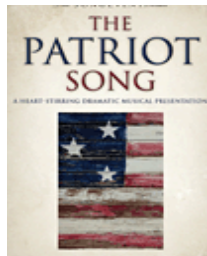

### STUDENT LIFE info:

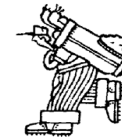

### CBC Disaster Relief Team

We want to develop a DR (Disaster Relief) team at Central to respond to disasters locally and throughout the world under the auspices of the Kentucky Baptist Convention. The three major areas of need are food preparation, chainsaw tree clearing and mud out work after flooding. The first step in the process is to become a certified DR volunteer. You may be certified by taking DR Phase 1 Training. If you have previously taken Phase 1 training more than 3 years ago, you must be re-certified by taking Phase 2 Training. This will be the LAST chance for recertification with your Phase 1 training. After July 23 everyone will have to start at the beginning—with Phase 1. Both of these training opportunities are being offered July 23 from 9-Noon at Porter Memorial Baptist Church in Lexington. The charge for Phase 1 training is \$40 and for Phase 2 is \$20. You may register online at KBC Disaster Relief Phase 1 Training. Please let us know in the office, if you are planning to attend and you would like to car pool. If we have enough interest we may take a bus.
