

### A Giant was Among Us

John Wooden died on June 4, 2010. He was ninety-nine. He was the fabled coach of UCLA from 1948-1975. He won ten NCAA basketball titles from 1964-1975.

He was one of my favorite all-time personalities. I was 11 years-old when he won his first NCAA championship and 22 when he won his last in 1975.

But this man seemed to transcend his sport. Why?

If you listen to his players speak of him you learn why. He invested time and values into "his boys." He not only wanted them to succeed on the court but he wanted them to succeed in life. He told his players, "We don't have to be superstars or win championships . . . All we have to do is learn to rise to every occasion, give our best effort and make those around us better as we do it."

When John Wooden graduated from high school in Centerton, his father gave him a list of things he suggested John live by. Here is the list:

- Be true to yourself.
- Make each day your masterpiece.
- Help others.
- Drink deeply from good books, especially the Bible.
- Make friendship an art.
- Build a shelter against a rainy day.
- Pray for guidance, count and give thanks for your blessings every day.

He also carried a poem in his wallet. The poem says, "Four things a man must learn to do if he would make his life more true:

- To think without confusion more clearly,
- To act from honest motives purely,
- To love his fellow-man sincerely,
- To trust in God and heaven securely."

John Wooden was a Christian. He lived out his faith as a man, husband, father and a coach at UCLA. That was his arena of influence. His love for Christ was seen and felt by how he treated those around him. His life was the message of how Christ can use one person yielded to Him to touch millions. Let us do the same!
