Statement of Faith Overview Chart

Most simply, our statement says that CFBC is a Christian, Evangelical, Baptist, Congregational church. Our statement of faith is divided into nineteen articles, which speak to the fact that we can be called by each of these names. The <u>Historically Christian</u> articles simply show what Christians have always believed, in other words, issues that there has traditionally been little dispute over in Christendom. The <u>Evangelical</u> category highlights the critical issues related to the gospel that were recovered during the Reformation. The <u>Baptist</u> and <u>Congregational</u> categories highlight the distinctive features of CFBC.

Take a moment and notice just how much of our Statement of Faith is devoted to stating the essentials of the Christian faith; essentials that we would have little to no disagreement over with any other Christian denomination. Then notice how that in just a few qualifying statements we express what signifies us to be a Baptist church.
