PRISON MINISTRY SERIES - Central will feature a prison ministry series in cooperation with David Chaffee, Regional Volunteer Coordinator for the Office of Faith and Citizen Programs, Colorado Department of Corrections. Central will present three volunteer opportunities to serve female offenders incarcerated in the Denver Women's Correctional Facility. Denver Women's Correctional Facility (DWCF) is the largest women's prison in the state with a capacity of 970 offenders.

TODAY: Kevin Condon, Chair, Colorado Kairos - "Kairos" is Greek and means "in the fullness of time." Kairos is an international prison ministry and has been active in Colorado for over 30 years.

March 10: Dr. Vie Thorgren, Executive Director of the Center for Spirituality at Work - Dr. Thorgren will talk to us about the successful "Making Choices" program which has operated in DWCF for 12 years.

This is a strategic one-on-one mentoring program for women mentors and female mentees.

March 17: Rev. Emily Cardin, "New Beginnings Church" - This church is held weekly on Friday evenings and the congregation is made up of the offenders who reside within DWCF. Emily will talk about its impact on the offenders and the needs of this population.
