



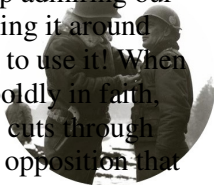

**SPIRITUAL LIFE RETREAT October 1-2, 2011 at beautiful Camp Lake Stephens**

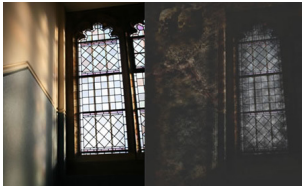
MUSIC: Eddie Willis and the Narrow Path

## FRIGHT FEST, OCTOBER 29



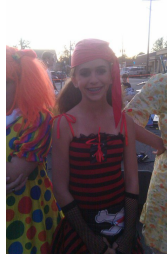
