Central UMC has formed and shaped dozens of people who have gone on to ordained ministry and missionary work. Pastor Greg Henneman served as Associate Pastor at Central from 2009-2014 and now serves as a missionary with Global Ministries at the Church for All People in Columbus, Ohio. This church is seeking to build a "front porch to the kingdom of God" in a low-income community. Working to bring the gift of abundant life, in 2015, Greg's Healthy Eating and Living (HEAL) program dispersed over 594,000 pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables to more than 27,000 individuals in a food insecure community, taught over 400 hours of health education, served more than 9,000 meals, and graduated 68 children and adults from cooking classes. One participant who lost 15 pounds in 2015 shared, "This program is making a marked difference in our community."
