In the Gospel of Luke, 17: 20-21, we read this, "Once Jesus was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God was coming, and he answered, "The kingdom of God is not coming with things that can be observed; nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or 'There it is!' For, in fact, the kingdom of God is among you." I have always loved this passage of scripture. Jesus' instructions to the Pharisees reminds us that, like all the parables, we must be attentive to the way in which the Holy Spirit is

working already in our world. The Kingdom of God is already here, and yet there is also more to come!

As we begin our annual Lenten journey to Jerusalem, where the events of Holy Week will unfold before us, and where we will experience the pathos of Jesus, I want to encourage you to focus on how the Kingdom of God is in our midst.
