Earlier this spring when I announced that both Traci Bailey and Scott Carver would be leaving the staff I also indicated that this was the opening of a new chapter in the life of Central UMC. To be honest, it was easier to say that than it was to realize what it might mean. A case in point is Vacation Bible School. Even as our staff changed and I knew we needed to do things differently I looked at VBS as being a ministry that would continue in the same way. What has come to my attention is that VBS is a great test case for our new reality as a congregation.



With that said, I have made the decision to postpone VBS from June 27 to a date to be announced in August after school starts.

I am grateful for the people who have already begun to work on VBS and for the folks who have volunteered to assist with the ministry. Trust me when I tell you that we will still need leaders, helpers, planners, etc.

My hope at this point is that we can hold a VBS event on a Saturday that will not only be a ministry for the children of our congregation but one in which we can invite children from our neighborhood and Lowell Elementary to participate; thus the August date.

Friends, the ministry of the church—the very purpose of the church—is to extend Christ's love beyond the walls of our facility. This means that our practices must mirror our purpose and VBS presents us with the opportunity to do this. Please know that if you have any questions I am available to talk.



Next Sunday our newly appointed pastoral staff member, **Rev. Kelly Brooks**, will be joining us as part of the Central team. Kelly is a provisional deacon in the Annual Conference and her primary role will be connecting people to ministry in the church and beyond. Kelly previously worked at Saranam, Family Promise, First UMC, and was most recently the pastor at Grace UMC in Albuquerque.

**Rev. Janet Norden**, a provisional elder in the Annual Conference, continues in her dual appointment at Central and University Heights. Here at Central Janet's primary ministry is in pastoral care, Community of Hope, and Family Promise while at University Heights she is pastor in charge and has Sunday responsibilities.

Mary Lust, our Director of Ministries and Operations, will be full-time through the end of summer and then when she moves to Abilene her role is going to change. Mary will be working remotely as she finishes a number of significant financial projects and she will also be coming back to Central once a month to meet with administrative committees. Mary will be doing this at least until the first of the year when we will reassess our needs as a congregation and make plans to move forward accordingly.


