On any given day there are 3000 homeless in our city: waking up on a bench - under a bridge - beneath a tree; having no place to clean up; hungry with nothing to eat; cold with no coat to warm the body. This time of year provides us with a unique opportunity to help solve one of the most desperate problems of the

homeless -the lack of warm coats to help keep the winter temperatures at bay.

HELPING HANDS BIBLE

STUDY For many years Central UMC has helped people with basic physical needs by providing sack lunches, clothing items, bus passes,



and toiletries through our Helping Hands ministry. For the last year we have made a more intentional effort to attend to people's spiritual needs by offering a Helping Hands Bible study every Friday. From a core group of four people, this study has grown to average between 12 and 15 people. MULTIMEDIA RENOVATION UPDATE Hi folks! Since the majority of the Life Center renovation is complete, I jogged over to the Sanctuary to check out the activity there. The construction team is busy

installing upgraded electrical service and various new wires and cables. Boom lifts, scissor lifts and one-person units. So many perches! The Fowler crew has installed the main speakers and they look so nice! Very thin, very low profile. They installed audio monitors for the choir, which also blend in very nicely in the chancel area. On the video side, the new projectors and screens are in place. And there are a couple new rows of stage lights installed way up in the rafters. The schedule calls for the rest of the equipment to be installed during November. Remaining work includes replacing the floor with a new cork floor and reinstalling the pews. Our first event in the renovated space will be the Messiah concert on December 6th and our classic services will begin on December 8th.

We are seeking volunteers to help learn and operate all the new media equipment. Interested? Look for a volunteer signup list in the Gathering Area. We are in the process of training our first technical team and will roll out the rest of the training soon.
