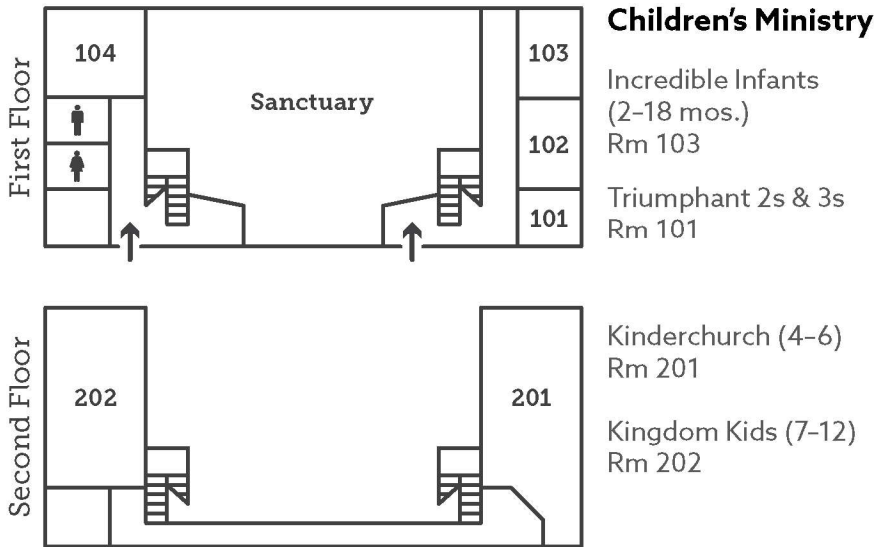


Just visiting?
