

## Chapel by the Sea Park Days – Summer 2017

**What:** Bring a lunch and join us on the playground. We will play, rain or shine.

**When:** Wednesdays. Meet at the park around 10:00 and play until noon. Come late, stay late, whatever you want. It is flexible.

May 31	Storck Park	<b>7020 Clarks Rd.</b> off of Rabbit Creek Rd. beautiful views!
June 7	Stephenson	<b>13024 Stephenson St.</b> This park has a new play structure with a very tall slide. There is a nice grassy area for lawn games as well. It is tucked in a neighborhood. Take Old Seward south, past Huffman, turn left on Helen, right on Stephenson. (between Huffman and DeArmoun on the east side of Old Seward.)
June 14	Jewel Lake	<b>4342 W. 88<sup>th</sup> Ave.</b> Go west on 88 <sup>th</sup> from Jewel Lake Rd., through the neighborhood, to the park and lake. Parking can fill up on warm days, so come early or expect a walk. Watch lifeguard signs about swimmers' itch, but it should be ok if the water hasn't warmed up too much. Play in the water and sand, play structure and volleyball court also.
June 21	Huffman Elem.	<b>12000 Lorraine St.</b> off Huffman, just before Elmore Rd. Recycled rubber under play structures and open fields.
June 28	Moen Park	<b>17761 Goldenview Dr.</b> From the New Seward Hwy, go East on Rabbit Creek Rd., right on Goldenview, 1.5 miles on left
July 5	Oceanview	<b>13420 Jarvi Dr.</b> New park with two ziplines, climbing structure, regular play structure and tennis courts
July 12	Sand Lake Elem.	<b>7500 Jewel Lake Rd.</b> on the west side of Jewel Lake, north of Dimond and South of Raspberry. Go around the left side of the school building. Has rubber mulch

July 19	Kincaid Elem.	<b>4900 Raspberry Rd.</b> Nice big play structure here. A great hill to roll down, even a little track for riding toys, if you'd like. Tastee Freeze is nearby, so pack some cash for ice cream on the way home.
July 26	Bear Valley Elem.	<b>15001 Mountain Air Dr.</b> From New Seward, go east on Rabbit Creek Rd., pass Goldenvue, at top of Rabbit Creek but before the firehouse and Clarks Rd., go right on Mountain Air, left at the dead end, straight at stop sign, and around the left of the school
August 2	Thunderbird Falls	<b>Thunderbird Falls Trail Parking Lot</b> LET US KNOW IF YOU ARE COMING SO WE CAN WAIT FOR YOU! Meet at <b>10:30</b> for a fun hike. Go north on the Glenn Hwy and follow the signs for "Thunderbird Falls." It's about 30 minutes outside of Anchorage. No playground here, but we will hike (slowly) up to see the waterfall and then down to the river. Good for jogging strollers, except for maybe the last little bit near the river. Pack snacks for the hike, plus a picnic and we will all eat in the parking lot when we get back. Hike is about 1 mile and can be done in about an hour- or longer if the kids explore more.
August 9	Jade Park	<b>9100 Jade St.</b> north off of West Dimond, just west of Jewel Lake Rd., with playground, hill, and field
