








OUR DREAM

KNOWING STUDENTS

- Through our advisory program, every adult in the building will be responsible for a group of 12-13 students — a "family" at school
- Know your child well work that's too easy and too challenging;
 your child will have a Personalized Learning Plan
- Meet regularly; time and content adjusted for age and development at each grade level
- Teach your child Mindfulness Techniques to help them adapt socially
 & emotionally to various situations
- Communicate with you about struggles & triumphs



LANGUAGE IMMERSION

- Every student can become conversationally fluent in Spanish or Mandarin by the end of 8th grade
- Early learning of a second language is researchproven to lead to higher student achievement
- Bilingualism provides students with a competitive advantage
- Learning about another culture promotes global and cultural awareness

ABOUT LAB

School size:

- Currently have 280 students in grades K-4
- We will grow to serve 540 students in grades K-8 over the next 5 years

Class size:

- K-2: largest classes each day has 21 students
- 3-4: largest classes each day has 25 students

ABOUT CHARTERS

What is a charter school?

- Tuition-free, public school
- Governed by an independent Board of Directors that reports directly to NC Department of Public Instruction
- Funding
 - Funding from NC state for each student
 - 501©3 non-profit organization
 - Eligible for grants and fundraising opportunities
- Open to ALL kids no admissions requirements
- 100% lottery enrollment process

ENRICHMENT

- Each student rotates through Art, Music, Drama, & Maker Lab as a 9 week project-based enrichment experience
- •45 minutes of Physical Education is offered daily; students rotate through Lab Fit; Sports Skills; Taekwondo; Golf; Street Dance; Ballroom Dance, etc.
- 20 mins of Recess/Free Play everyday
- New First Ward Park as our green space

Your family should consider the following points as you think about whether Charlotte Lab School is a good fit for your child:

- Changing classes daily beginning in Kindergarten, all students have a homeroom, and they transition to different content classes during the day
- 2. Subject area teachers your family will maintain contact and manage school work from multiple teachers



- 3. Direct contact with advisors your child's advisor serves as your primary liaison with the school; knows and supports your child socially, emotionally, & academically
- 4. Homework Philosophy we believe homework should only be assigned when it is meaningful and will be checked by teachers; it is assigned weekly so families have flexibility when determining when to get it done



- 5. Differentiated instruction it may be frustrating for some students to know and see that everyone is not doing the same thing
- 6. Flexible Walls sound and movement can be challenging and somewhat distracting for students who may have difficulty focusing on their own

- 7. Limited Green Space recess and free play looks different for our students because we do not have a large playground space yet; occasionally groups may walk to First Ward Park
- 8. Comfort with Walking Trips our students, faculty, and volunteers walk in/around Uptown weekly; we do everything we can to ensure their safety on these trips

- 9. Start Up Organization we are constantly learning and making improvements to our school processes and communication; we appreciate constructive feedback from parents, but recognize that adjusting to changes may be difficult for some families
- 10. Encourage Volunteering we want ALL families to engage with us and believe that parents/guardians should volunteer in ways that makes sense for your family



WHAT'S NEXT?

- Official application period is January 4th February 26th:
 - Sibling Policy we offer admissions preference to siblings of students currently enrolled, <u>if seats are</u> <u>available</u>
 - Separate Application from CMS Magnet Schools
 - Lottery held on March 14th
