

Summer Image ‘Scavenger Hunt’

We would like our founding classes to collect images that we can use in our science Quests during the up-coming school year. We will locate the images on a map; we will share them with classmates, and turn them into data relevant to our Quest projects.

Different grade levels should collect different images:

- Rising kindergarteners should collect images of their **favorite flowers** for the Design a Garden Wall Quest.
- Rising 1st graders should collect images of **playgrounds** for the design a Playground Quest.
- Rising 2nd graders should collect images of their **favorite garden, flower, plant, or tree** for the Design an Urban Garden Quest.
- Rising 3rd graders should collect images of their **favorite cookies** for the Perfect Cookie Forces Quest.
- Rising 4th graders should collect images of their **favorite foods** for the School Lunch Quest.

We encourage students to collect images in and around Charlotte as well as on their summer trips (this will help us to connect and learn about geography).
