Highlights from the 2017 Annual Meeting

This year's Annual Breakfast, Movie and Meeting attendance was fantastic! If you weren't there, then you missed a delicious meal prepared by Ruth Ann Wrucke, Penny McCulloch, Diane and Trask Leonard, among others. The second annual Annual Meeting Movie was also well-received.

In addition to the gospel read in church, there was a lot of good news to report. In 2016, attendance was up from an average Sunday attendance of 80 to 85 (although part of the increase can be attributed to the fact that Christmas fell on a Sunday). The number of pledges and the average amount of pledges also increased. This was due to your overwhelming generosity and the stellar efforts of a fantastic Stewardship Committee led by Ed Jennings, which included, Tricia Christensen, James Coker, Lisa Hill, Courtney Kingston, Robert Redfern-West, and help from Tim and Wendy McAdam, Todd Reimund and Scott Power. **We went from 78 pledges for 2016 at the same time last year for a total of \$288,000 to 83 pledges for 2017, totaling approximately \$360,000 with pledges still arriving. Well done! The generosity of the congregation in time, talent, and treasure is remarkable.**

We said thank you to Diane Leonard who served and steered the parish faithfully as Senior Warden during a particularly difficult two years of transition at Christ Church and Carillon. We also recognized the dedicated service of our longtime treasurer Annemarie Redmond and outgoing Vestry members, Angela Hey, Ed Jennings, Stanny Llewellyn, and Robert Redfern-West. We then introduced our new Senior Warden Carrie Cronkey and welcomed our new Vestry members Ann Dauer, Lisa Hill and Claiborne Jones. We also welcomed our new Music Director, Michael Glick!

There was also great news on the Carillon Preschool front. We are nearly at full enrollment already for next year, and will have a waitlist for some classes. We are giving the Director discretion to give priority to pledging members of Christ Church in good standing and to families with siblings already at Carillon. This does not guarantee a spot but may be considered.


